#### Itinerary

Check into your accommodation from 2pm, or earlier if it is ready.

For adults, a soak in the cliff-top spa may be just the ticket before your big Irish night.

From 5pm – head to the Highlander Arms to enjoy hearty Irish fare, music, revelry and Irish activities.

Check-out the stars before retiring to bed and have the sweetest Irish dreams.
